Dear OHS Parents and Guardians,

I hope this letter finds you well. With only two weeks until the start of the school year, we are working hard to finalize details, schedules, and to ensure we are ready for a successful opening to the start of the 2020-2021 school year! We wanted to share a few reminders and updates for you:

**Picture day** will be Thursday, September 10 (B day students) and Friday, September 11 (A day students). If your student is participating in Distance Learning, students should attend picture day on their corresponding alphabetical day: students with last names L-Z on September 10 from 9AM-12 noon, and students with last names A-K on September 11 from 9AM- 12 noon. Students can report to the main office. If you are not comfortable with your student coming into the building for school pictures, you may submit a photo of your own. The photo should be a head and shoulder shot taken against a solid background. More details to come on how to submit these photos.

**Student schedules** will be available beginning tomorrow in StudentVUE and ParentVUE. Please understand that these schedules are tentative, and may be subject to change due to balancing of sections, etc. Students should check online the weekend prior to the first day of school for a final, official schedule.

**Parking permits** go on sale tomorrow, beginning at 9 AM. Information on parking can be found on our OHS [Transportation website](#).
